

Over the last four years there has been a strong increase in demand for more world-wide locations and more universities to choose from. #### Work Shadowing opportunity for our postgraduate nursing students

A fantastic opportunity is now available for our MSc International Nursing Studies students. In addition to an excellent academic experience and our state-of-the-art clinical facilities, there's a chance to practice with our nursing and healthcare teams.

Located in major hospital in Essex and Cambridgeshire you will (subject to occupational health and Disclosure and Barring Service clearance) engage in a six-week (approximately) nursing work shadowing placement in the second semester of your course. We're offering our international nursing students, not intending to register in the UK, a rare opportunity to observe and experience UK nursing practice as part of our highly skilled nursing, medical and inter-professional care communities.

#### Recent study

**Our professor involved in first ever study of stress on the wards in real time** Nurses are less likely to be stressed by the demands of a day on the ward if they feel valued and in control, according to a pioneering study.

During two work shifts, 100 nurses were asked to complete electronic diaries and had their heart rates continuously measured to see monitor their stress levels. The study – the first to measure the effects of stress on nurses throughout their working day – found that the actual tasks assigned to them had little impact on their stress levels.

However, what did make a difference was whether the nurse felt in control of the work, and whether they felt valued or appreciated, such as when interacting with patients (direct care). These direct care tasks did lead nurses to report feeling more stressed than other work, such as completing paperwork, but they also reported direct care to be more rewarding than other tasks.

Heart rate was higher by around three beats per minute in those who appraised their work as more demanding or requiring more effort. If the nurses felt in control of their work, they felt less tense, more cheerful and less tired.

Our Professor Patricia Schofield was one of the principal investigators in the study, which was led by the University of Aberdeen.

Professor Schofield, Deputy Dean for Research within Anglia Ruskin's Faculty of Health, Social Care & Education, said:

"It takes a certain type of person to go into nursing. A caring and compassionate nature is a pre-requisite, but what this study shows is that in order to get the best out of our staff on the wards, this needs to be a two-way street.

"Nursing is a tough, but rewarding job and if healthcare professionals feel appreciated it can reduce their stress levels and help them cope with the demands of a day on the ward a lot better."

# Obtaining Your Student Visa - The Ultimate Challenge

#### The Visa Pathway BCIE will show you the way

If you plan to study in the UK you will need a 'Tier 4 (General) Student Visa'. To obtain your visa you will need to score a certain number of points under the 'Points Based System' (PBS). This system was introduced by the UKVI in an attempt to both streamline and make more transparent the entire visa application process. In 2015 the Biometric Identification Document (BID) was introduced alongside the Immigration Health Surcharge (IHS) and the Biometric Residence Permit (BRP). This puts the UK in line with the USA where health insurance has always been required.

The good news is that you may get an answer from the UKVI a little bit more quickly - but the bad news is that this may simply mean that you get a refusal letter sooner rather then later!

This is where the expertise and track record of BCIE comes into play. We have a student visa success rate in excess of 97% and even where some of our students get a refusal, we pull out all the stops to turn the decision around. In each of our offices we have fully trained visa specialists and they will help you throughout the visa application process. This is where the visa expertise of the BCIE team can make all the difference – often turning those bitterly disappointing refusal letters into joyous student visas.

If you would like to study in Australia the BCIE team currently has a 100% student visa success rate! As long as you follow our advice and as long as you are a genuine student and meet the 'Genuine Temporary Entrant' (GTE) requirements you will have an excellent chance of obtaining your Australian visa through BCIE.

However obtaining a student visa is no easy task as any student who has attempted to apply on their own will tell you. The whole process is complicated, time consuming and daunting. Therefore it is always best to apply for your visa in the first place through one of the BCIE offices. In this way you may well avoid an initial visa refusal – and this is important given that such a refusal would stay on your records at the Embassy or High Commission.

So how long does it take to obtain a visa? We always advise our students that obtaining admission into one of our universities is just the tip of the iceberg and that the real challenge still lies ahead i.e. obtaining your student visa. Each case is different and much depends on which country you decide to study in. Typically it may take 2 or 3 months to obtain a student visa for the UK, Australia or the USA and up to 6 months to obtain a Canadian study permit. Therefore it's really important you visit your nearest BCIE office and start the ball rolling well in advance of your intended departure date.

What is involved in the visa application process? In all cases you will need to submit meticulous paperwork with supporting documentation. However our BCIE visa protocol officers have been rigorously trained and they are there to hold your hand and help you to prepare and submit such documentation.

As for studying in the UK and the USA, you will be required to attend an interview. Again we are here to help you and the rule is 'Don't Panic!' Where necessary we will take you through a rigorous mock interview in preparation for the real thing.

BCIE has good working relationships with the UKVI, and the Canadian, USA and Australian visa authorities. The BCIE directors are in regular contact with the entry clearance managers at the UKVI to make sure that we are completely up



to date with visa policies and procedures. We carefully follow such advice and train our in-country BCIE visa specialists accordingly. In this way over the years, we have developed a good rapport with the UKVI and with the Canadian, USA and Australian visa authorities and we know from first hand experience that this strategy of working together with the visa authorities helps our students, our universities and the BCIE team.


